GROUSE POINTING TEST – SUNDAY 31st MARCH 2019

Entries Close Thursday 14th March, 2019

If required a draw will take place on Friday 15th March, 2019 after which details will be e-mailed out.

JUNIOR – for dogs over 6 months of age and under 2 years of age as of 1st January 2019. To be judged on Grouse. Ground game to be judged for steadiness only.

ADULT – For dogs over 2 years of age as of 1st January 2019. To be judged on Grouse. All other game to be judged for steadiness only.

Dogs will be assessed and the following grading's awarded if considered worthy: **Excellent, Very Good and Good.**

Dogs will be run individually into the wind, where possible, for a minimum of 10 minutes; the first minute will not be assessed in order to allow the dog to settle. Natural working ability will take precedence. Priority will be given to game finding and therefore no game will be shot or dogs assessed on retrieving. No dog will be eliminated unless deemed to be out of control.

ENTRY FEES

BCGB Members £30 per dog Non-members £35 per dog

Places limited to 12 dogs.

All entries to be sent to the Field Trial Secretary – **cheques to be made payable to The BRITTANY CLUB of GREAT BRITAIN.** No entries will be accepted without full payment.

If entries are oversubscribed a ballot will take place. Preference will be given to:

1. Members Brittany Junior dogs
2. Members with other HPR breeds Junior dogs
3. Members Brittany Adult dogs
4. Members with other HPR breeds Adult dogs
5. Non-members Juniors dogs
6. Non-members Adult dogs

If entering more than one dog please state preference in a ballot.

Points to Note

Dogs are expected to have some experience of game and must have a good recall.

Please bring appropriate clothing for all weather conditions.

This is sheep country and there will be sheep grazing on the moor, all dogs must therefore be "broken to sheep".

Due to limited parking, spectators will only be allowed with prior approval.

Bitches in season will not be allowed on the ground.

The judge's decision is final.

A 4x4 vehicle is needed to get up onto the moor, please make sure you can buddy up with someone as we will need to keep vehicles to a minimum. A good level of fitness is required for this moor.
